10 1/2" X 14 3/4"

1000 Uptown Plush Color of your choice	Cut out with pattern	3/8
6282 So Sweet, So Soft Color of your choice	Cut one strip 2 1/4" wide *WOF. Cut into one 2 1/4" X 11" piece	1/8
1 Package	Large Rick Rack	
1 Package	Bias Tape	
1 Piece	Velcro or a Snap	

*WOF = Width of Fabric

Sewing Instructions

Make a pattern by placing the two pattern pieces together matching A's. This material will make more than one bib.

Cut out bib from uptown plush material using pattern..

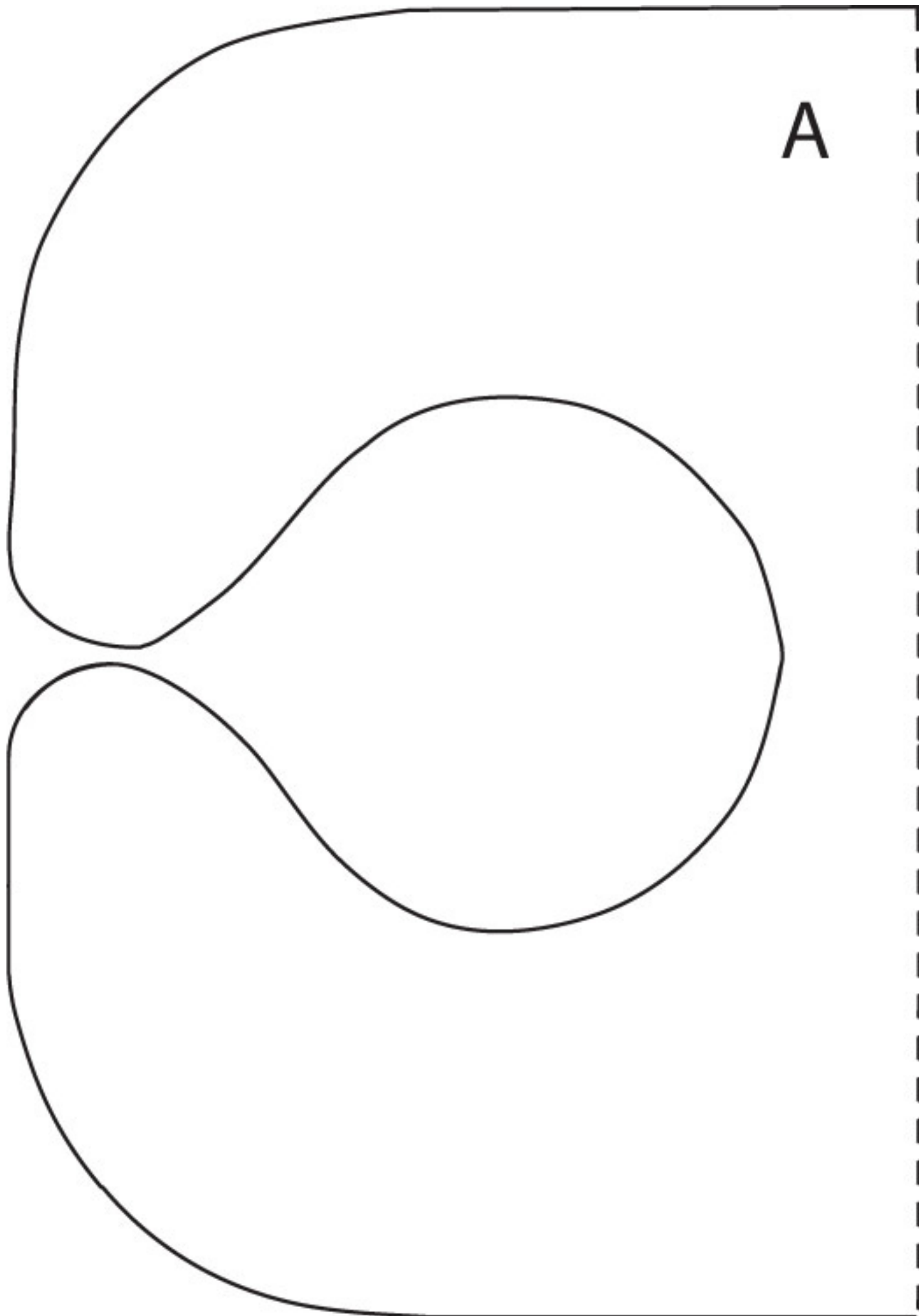
Take the 2 1/4" X 11" strip of polka dot material and press under 1/4" all the way around piece. Pin to front of bib 2 1/4" up from bottom of bib and top stitch down all the way around.

Sew a piece of large rick rack down through the middle of this polka dot material turning under 1/4" on each end.

Turn bias tape under 1/4" from end and with right sides together sew on back side of bib by laying bias out flat with raw edges meeting on edge and sewing 1/4" from edge on fold line starting at top left neck, turn under 1/4" at end. Turn bias to front side of bib pin and top stitch down going all around the edge of bib and neck opening.

Turn rick rack under 1/4" on end and lie on top of bias starting at same place as bias and pin and sew around edge of bib and neck opening. Turn under 1/4" at end of sewing.

Sew a piece of Velcro on to both pieces of neck opening or put a snap on both pieces.



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
